

## Safety Instructions for Trailers

Congratulations on purchasing your new **FoodTrailerClub** trailer!

We hope it will serve you well and bring you many years of reliable use.

When used properly and in accordance with these safety instructions, your trailer is guaranteed to be free from any structural manufacturing defects.

To comply with the warranty conditions, you must follow the criteria below and carefully observe all safety guidelines.

### Safety Instructions

#### Before entering the trailer

- Secure the jockey wheel firmly in place before uncoupling the trailer.
- Lower, lock, and stabilize all four support legs before entering the trailer.
- Use the handbrake or wheel chocks when the trailer is parked.
- Wait at least one hour before connecting the refrigerator or freezer to allow cooling fluids to stabilize.

**Important:** It is strictly forbidden to remain inside the trailer while driving. Doing so may result in serious injury or death.

#### Do not move the trailer while:

- the coupling is not properly attached and locked onto the tow ball;
- the jockey wheel has not been stowed before driving;
- the safety chains are not correctly attached to the towing vehicle (we recommend crossing the chains on the D-rings of the vehicle);
- the four support legs are not fully retracted;

#### Check the tires and wheels:

- Check the tire pressure regularly;

- Recommended pressure: 40-45 psi , depending on the trailer model;
- Ensure that all doors and windows are locked before departure;
- Make sure cabinets and loose items are securely fastened;
- The load must be evenly distributed and properly secured inside the trailer;
- The trailer lights (brake lights, indicators, and side lights) must be connected and tested.

### **Before using the water system**

- Fill the water tank (located under the chassis) with a garden hose until water flows out from the upper opening.
- Connect your trailer to a suitable power source.
- Connect the electric faucet plug to the socket located under the sink.
- Briefly open the cold-water tap to fill the system and check the water flow.
- Turn on the electric faucet to allow hot water to flow.

### **Important notes:**

- Always turn off the electric faucet when not in use to prevent overheating or unnecessary power consumption.
- Never operate the water system when dry, as this may damage the pump and heating elements..
- If no hot water is produced or the water flow is weak, check the pump and ensure there is no air trapped in the system.

### **Gas Safety Instructions**

#### **Safe handling and use of gas cylinders**

- Lock the gas compartment when using the trailer in public areas to prevent unauthorized access or tampering.
- Check for leaks using soapy water—never use an open flame.
- Ensure proper ventilation and secure all gas cylinders during transport and operation.
- Open and close gas valves carefully, checking for leaks each time.

### **In case of emergency:**

- Immediately close the gas valve if a leak is suspected.
- Stop all activities involving open flames and evacuate the area.
- Warn all personnel and set up warning signs to keep others away.

#### **Recommended safety measures:**

- Equip the trailer with a fire extinguisher and a gas leak detector for emergencies.
- Perform regular maintenance of gas hoses, valves, and pressure regulators to ensure proper functioning.

#### **Important Hazards**

Loss of control over the trailer or the combination with the towing vehicle can lead to serious injury or death.

#### **Common causes of trailer instability include:**

- Incompatible towing vehicle and trailer combination.
- Excessive speed for road conditions.
- Failure to adapt driving behavior when towing.
- Overloading or improper weight distribution.
- Incorrect or incomplete trailer coupling.
- Incorrect tire pressure.
- Failure to retighten wheel nuts regularly.
